1.1 What Is a Research

Your task as a researcher is alway to in a very very incremental way increase this overall knowledge that is existent. And I am not just talking about writing a whole new theories, but even something small is considered an "increase in knowledge". For instance if you will research which meals do people in your home city prefer the most, that is also some new information that no one ever found out.
